



APAC Summer Internship Program

The Asian Pacific American Coalition (APAC) is a community-based, non-partisan, non-profit 501(c)(3) corporation whose mission is to cultivate civic engagement to forward the voices of San Diego's Asian Pacific American community.

The purpose of the APAC summer internship program is to **help train and educate future community, political, and government leaders**. Possible internship positions available may include the San Diego Mayor's office, County Board of Supervisors, City Council, and/or with the San Diego District Attorney's office.

Eligibility

1. Each applicant should be in good academic standing and currently enrolled full time, in an accredited academic institution in pursuit of at least a high school diploma or a college degree program.
2. Each applicant should be between the ages of 16 to 25.
3. Each applicant should have at least a 3.0 grade point average.
4. Each applicant should reside in San Diego County.
5. Each applicant should be a US citizen or permanent resident.

Guidelines

1. A completed application will consist of:
 - a. Completed application form
 - b. Current school transcript
 - c. Submit a 2-page personal narrative, single spaced, and in 12 font type. Please also include why you would want an internship, what your future plans include, and how are you involved with the San Diego community.
 - d. Copy of proof of US citizenship or permanent residency.
2. A completed application must be submitted by **5pm of March 31, 2023**.

7. The acceptance into the summer internship program is ultimately at the discretion of the hiring employer.
8. At the completion of the summer internship program, the intern will receive a certificate and a stipend of \$2,000 from APAC.
9. In the event the summer intern does not complete their internship for the full term or the intern discontinues their course of study, their entire stipend will be forfeited.
